Revision of the ITS Directive and MMTIS

- Proposal for a Revision presented in December 2021. Key points addressed in the Revision:
 - Lack of interoperability and lack of continuity of applications systems and services;
 - Lack of concertation and cooperation among stakeholders;
 - Unresolved issues related to the availability and sharing of data support ITS services.
- Revision of MMTIS Delegated Regulation planned for Q2 2023:
 - Mandate accessibility of real-time / dynamic data;
 - Mandate accessibility of new data categories (occupancy / historic data);
 - Address questions of data quality and alignment with RTTI Delegated Regulation



MDMS initiative

- Proposal planned for Q2 2023:
 - Facilitate integration of all modes and all mobility products by addressing technical obstacles;
 - Facilitate integration by addressing unwillingness to share content and/or integrate operators in MDMS;
- Key considerations for the initiative:
 - Develop a FRAND framework for commercial agreements between operators and MDMS when selling tickets and mobility products;
 - Mandate to share content and integrate operators; when operators and MDMS are key gateway for users.
 - Additional obligations for MDMS: neutral display; information on GHG emission; B2G data sharing.
 - Integration of CRS Code of Conduct
