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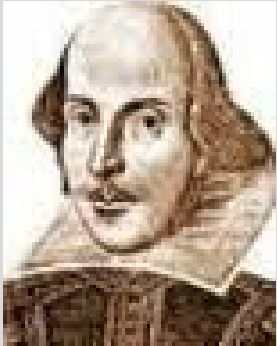




Road crashes

It is true that,

The young are, very often,
reckless!

But youth is the future
of mankind and it is the
utmost duty of society
to protect the young



It is also true that,



The young, especially
juveniles,
do not like to be told
what to do and what not
to do!



We, in Cyprus, are convinced that,

The way to tackle the problem, is to get the youth actively involved in the road safety efforts

In the conference,

Youth road safety workers from the EU member states and neighbouring regions, scientists and road safety officials and experts, shared their knowledge, experience and ideas, through the excellent presentations and the animated debates in the workshops





A series of invaluable conclusions were drawn.
The most important were:



The best way to raise road safety awareness among the young, is through a peer-to-peer interactive approach

(by trained and skilled young educators, who speak the same language and understand the young)



Conclusions (continued)



A culture of ***“Safe is Cool”***
should be created among
the young



Conclusions (continued)



Governments should
invest money in
providing safe transport
options to the young



Conclusions (continued)



Equal focus should be given by the police to checking for drug driving and drink driving



Conclusions (continued)

The message should be clear:

***There is no safe maximum
for drink or drugs
behind the wheel!***



Conclusions (continued)

Effective enforcement of rules and raising of road safety awareness should complement each other



Conclusions (continued)



Provide young bikers
with training
by experts
(role models)
for safe riding



Conclusions (continued)



Young bikers should be taught to
think beyond the rules



Conclusions (continued)



The young should be convinced that
distracted driving kills



Conclusions (continued)



Young women should be empowered ***to say no***



Conclusions (continued)



Young women should
also be convinced
not to reward
reckless driving



Conclusions (continued)



Parents are role models
to their children
and they should be
encouraged
to give the right example
in safe driving and safe
road behaviour in general



Conclusions (continued)



Parents should provide
driver training and driving experience
to their children



Conclusions (continued)

A graduated driving licence system is most appropriate.

Alternatively, some restrictions for novice drivers may be enforced



Conclusions (continued)

- Police and youth organizations should cooperate in raising road safety awareness of the young and in the design of enforcement activities targeting the young
- Youth organizations should be encouraged and empowered to support enforcement activities, with their own parallel awareness raising activities

Conclusions (continued)



Through the cooperation
between
the police and youth
organizations,
the young should be convinced
that ***enforcement aims to save
lives***



Finally, the most important conclusion was,



***Society should work together with youth
for the road safety of the young***
