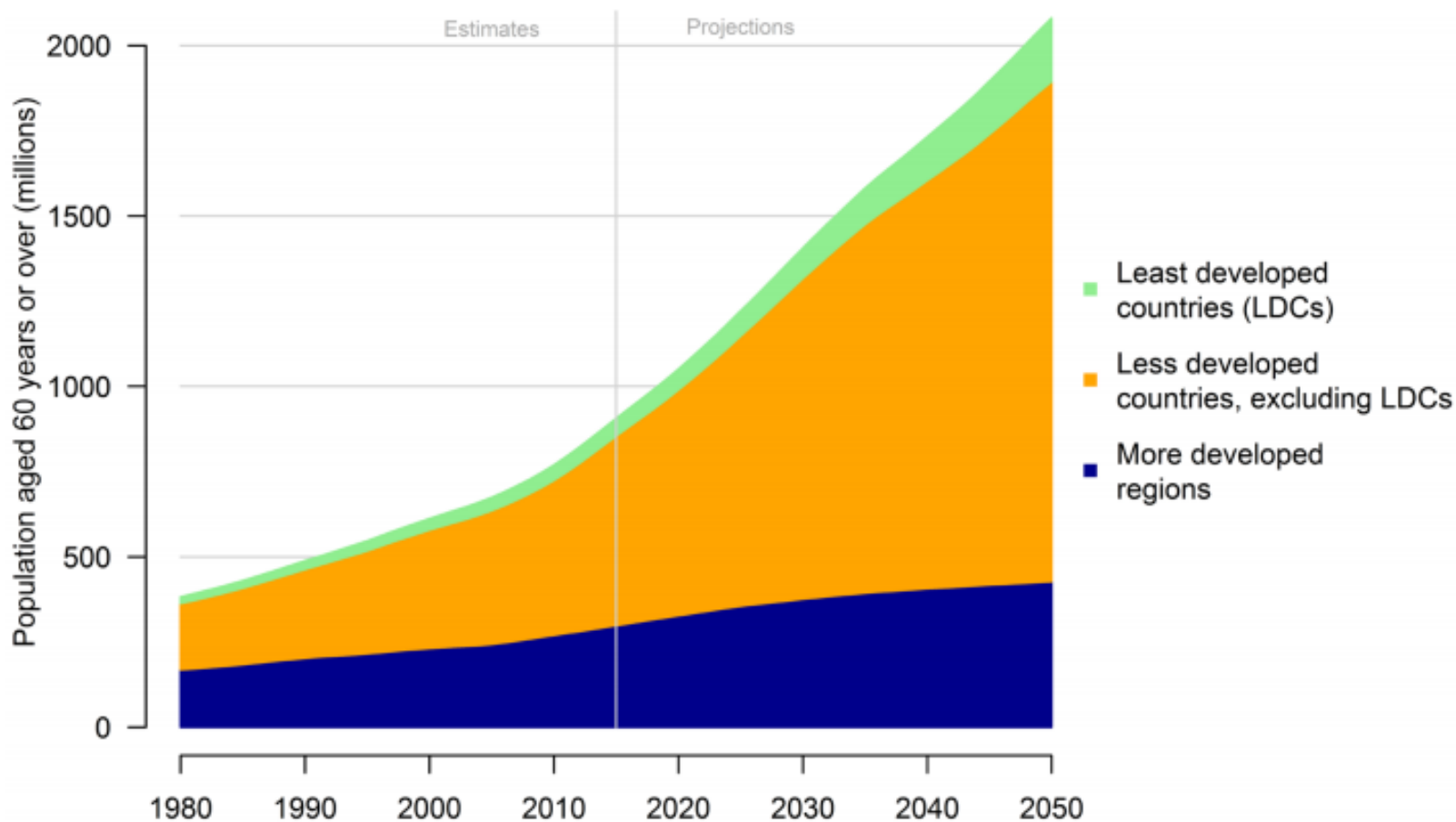

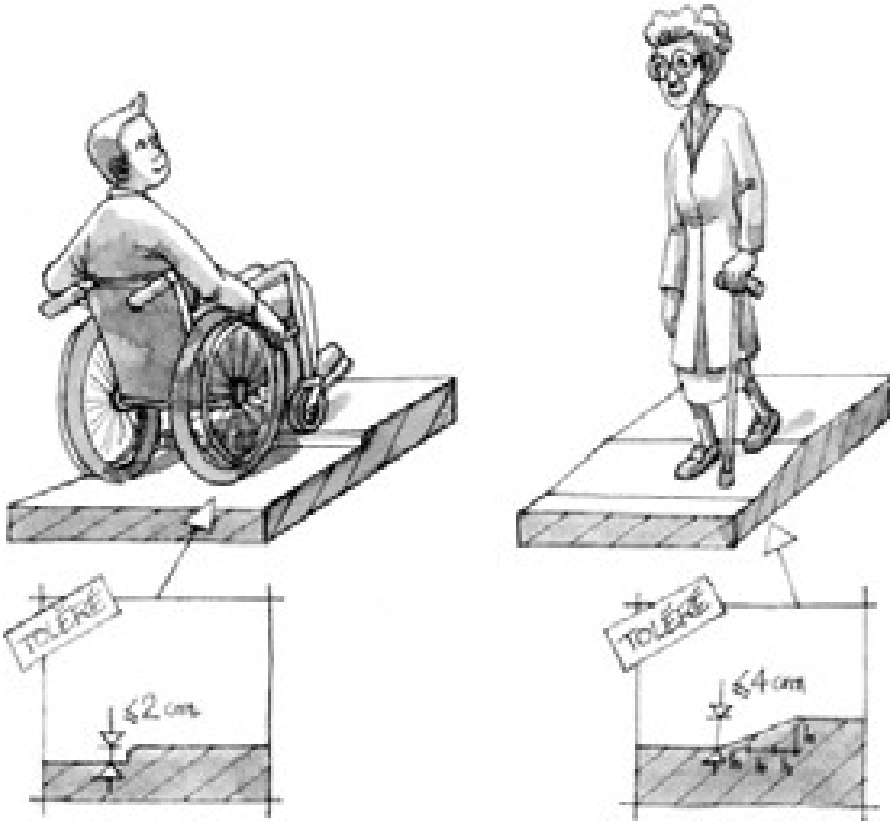

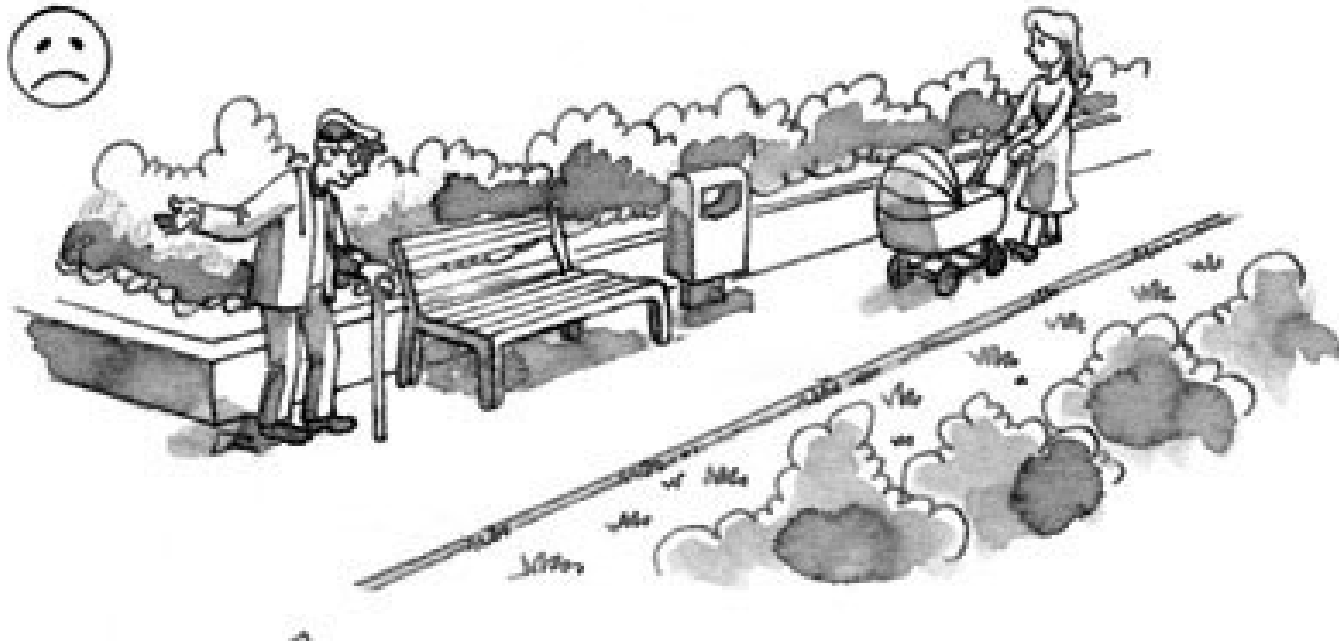


Sidewalk slopes and leaves can be dangerous for the elderly

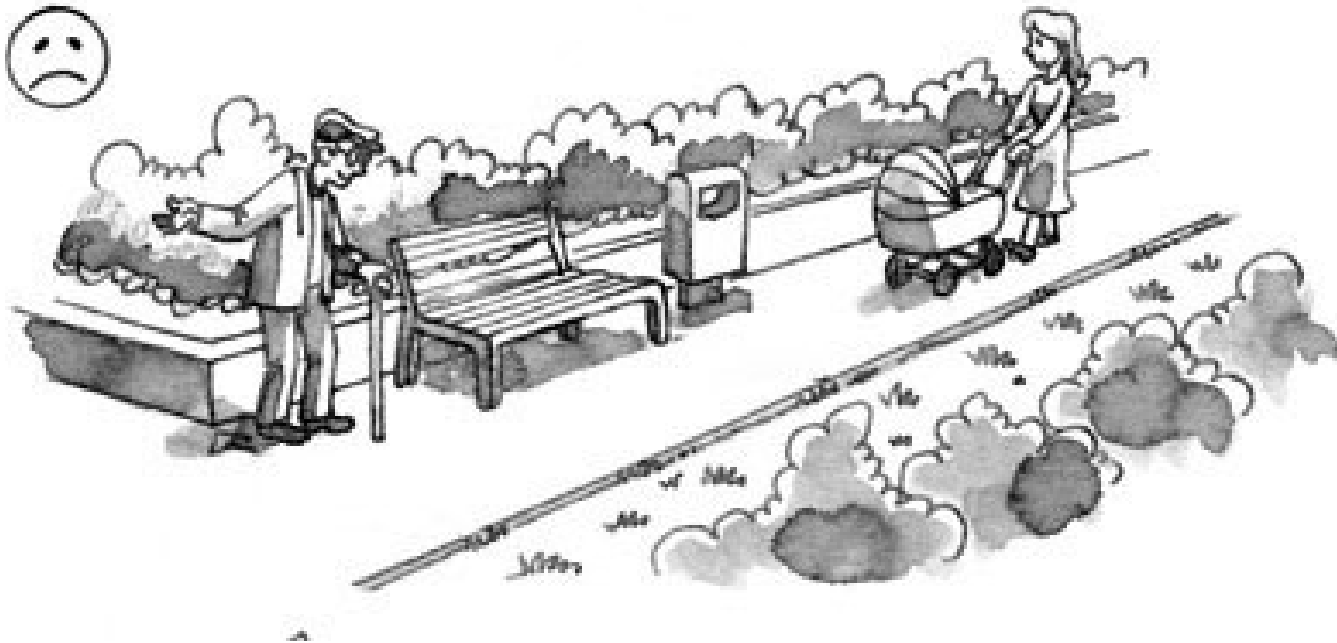
